Directions: From Santa Fe head north on I-25 or Old Las Vegas Hwy to US 285 towards Clines Corners. Head south on US 285 towards Lamy just after mile marker 285 turn right onto Astral Valley Road into the Galisteo Basin Preserve. Turn left on Thornton Ranch Road.
